GOLF COURSE AVAILABILITY TIMES:

- 1. Priority means you stop play straightaway to let the competition contenders play through and move in front of you. Then you resume play.
- 2. Courtesy means you can either choose to stop play and allow the competition contenders to play through, or finish playing that hole and allow the competitors to play the hole and move in front of you.
