



Golf Memberships – Terms and Conditions of Sale

1. All Golf Memberships run from 1st April – 31st March of the following year.
2. All Golf Memberships, regardless of when the subscription commences, will end on the 31st March of any given year.
3. All Golf applicants pay the full stated annual rate, without exception, when applying between 1st April – 30th September (Full Season Rate).
4. At the discretion of the Golf Course Club Manager, an Autumn (Mid-Season) and Winter Taster rate may be introduced on the 1st October and 1st January of any given season. This will be available to all members renewing/joining from these dates only and prices will not be released prior to these stated dates.

Membership Offerings

5. New Members to Bradfield College Golf Club may join for their first season on a Discounted New Member Introductory Fee. To be eligible for this they can never have been a member before (Full/Half-Season).
6. Members may receive a 10% discount if they join as a couple. To be eligible to receive this they must sign up and join at the same time, retrospective discounts will not be applied.
 - a. A couple is defined as 2 full paying adults age 26+. Both members must reside at the same address.
 - b. A family is defined as a maximum of 2 full paying adults age 26+ & any number of children (this can be a combination of Juniors and Youth members age 8-25 years). All family members must reside at the same postal address. The 10% discount is applied to the full paying adult memberships only when there are 2 adults, sole adults do not receive 10% discount.
 - c. Youth and Junior memberships are not eligible to be sold as joint memberships and receive 10% discount.
7. All Junior Members aged 8-18 years pay the same rate in any given season, no matter of status (Staff, St Andrews Staff, Sibling of pupils, Children of Parent / OB). No discount will be applied to this rate.
8. Children between the ages of 3-7 years may accompany their parent* to play Golf free of charge. They are not required to purchase a Green fee or junior membership.
**Please note their parent/accompanying adult must hold an active and paid for current golf season membership.*
9. All Children (Junior members and eligible staff children) must pay a Golf Membership in their own right from the start of the season following their 8th Birthday e.g. if a child turns 8 in December 2022, he/she will need to pay a Junior/staff membership fee from 1st April 2023.
10. It is recommended that all children (including Junior members) are accompanied up to the age of 11.
11. All Bradfield Staff*, St Andrews Staff*, Parent and OB/Alumni applicants must be checked and verified prior to sale of membership if they wish to receive a concession rate.

12. All Bradfield Staff membership prices are excluded from any additional discounted rates offered during a season. (Joint)
13. All St Andrews Staff, Parents and OB/Alumni may benefit from joint membership discounts.
14. Youth Memberships may be included within the St Andrews Staff discount if the applicant is eligible to be included and thus receive the additional discount. For Example, staff member age 24.
15. Present Parent, Past Parent & OB discounts will offered at the following rates:
 - a. Present Parents receive 50%, OB & Past Parents receive 25% discount.
 - b. To be eligible they must be verified before payment – this process can take 7-10 working days.
16. No discounted memberships will pay less than the Bradfield Staff / Junior Member season rate in any given season.
17. Social Memberships are withdrawn from sale and no longer offered as of the 1st April 2026.
18. All Bradfield college pupil Golf memberships must be arranged directly through the college – please refer to Nick Taylor: ntaylor@bradfieldcollege.org.uk . Pupils pay a set fee for the full year, there are no term time only discount packages.
19. All Golf Memberships are sold as a fixed term contract and are non-refundable.
20. Requests to freeze a subscription must be submitted in writing 30 days prior to the commencement of any request to the Golf Course Club Manager for consideration. Retrospective requests will not be considered. All requests will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis including the recognition that 30 days' notice may not always be possible.

Course Restrictions

21. The Course and Practice area will be **closed to all members and their guests** during the following times which will be deemed as **Pupil Only Time**. (*Term time only – please see website for specific dates*).

Monday	15:15 - 18:00
Tuesday	14:00 - 17:00
Wednesday	16:15 - 18:00
Thursday	14:00 - 17:00
Friday	16:15 - 17:00

At the end of Pupil Only Time, pupils and members will have **equal priority on the 1st tee**.

22. The Course and Practice area will be **closed to all pupils and their guests** during the following times which will be deemed as **Member Only Times / Club Session**.

Men's section – Mondays 9 - 11am
Ladies section – Wednesdays 9 – 11am
Mixed Roll Up – Sundays 9 – 11am

At the end of Member Only Times, pupils and members will have **equal priority on the 1st tee**.

Any Member or Pupil attempting to use the Golf Course within the above restricted times when they are not permitted to do so, will be asked to leave. Members will however be permitted to access and use the Members Club House and car park.

Guests & Green Fees

23. Green Fees: All Guest Green Fees must be purchased in advance of playing on the course – this must be done by the active Golf Member not the guest. Options to purchase: either in person or by calling the Sports Complex Reception team 01189 644 600. **NEW** – you can now purchase the day before you intend to play.

- Maximum of 3 guests per day.
- The Active Golf Member must accompany their guest at all times whilst they are on the course ensuring they follow all Bradfield Golf Course Rules.
- Restrictions to buy will apply during Pupil only time, Member only time & Course Closures for specified Matches & Events.

24. All Guests must display a valid Green Fee Ticket or have their email confirmation available on their phone at all times whilst on the course.

25. Any members who have guests accompanying them who have not paid will be asked to leave the course with immediate effect along with their guests.

Membership Administration

26. Replacement Access Card – the member will be charged for all replacement access cards.

27. Golf members with no connection to the College can only join as a Friend of Bradfield and must pay the fee due, this is included within the Golf Membership fee.

28. Refer a Friend Scheme may be offered – please see the scheme rules and Terms & conditions. (Bradfield and St Andrews Staff who are eligible for staff discounts cannot be referred).

29. Bradfield College Golf Club reserves the right to withdraw any Memberships, discounted Memberships, offers or the Refer a friend scheme at any time during any season.

30. Bradfield Golf Course will be closed at any time during a season as deemed necessary by the Golf Course Greenkeepers if it is deemed unsafe to play. Please always check the Golf Course Status on our website before play. Refunds / Credits will not be issued during these periods.

Golf Course Etiquette & Dogs

31. All Golfers are expected to adhere to the Bradfield Golf Course Safety & Etiquette rules which can be found on our website.

32. We ask all Members, Visitors & Guests of the Golf to respect our Staff at all times.

33. Dogs are not permitted on Bradfield Golf Course/Practice nets at any time.

- All dogs are banned from accompanying all members and their guests (inclusive of staff and pupils) whilst they are on the course playing.
- Any member who does bring their dog with them when playing will be asked to leave.
- Please note this does not affect the public footpath and right of way. General walkers may still have dogs with them but will be requested to always keep them on leads and reminded to stay on the designated footpaths whilst walking through the course.

34. Bradfield Golf Club & Course values the safety of all legitimate users of the course. The course is now patrolled twice a day, 7 days a week by both Course Marshalls and Bradfield Security. Anyone using the facilities (not limited to the car park, drive way, practice nets or clubhouse) or the Golf Course without a valid membership, guest pass or permission to be there will be asked to leave with immediate effect.

Addendum -

****Staff/St Andrew Staff** membership is available to active staff and their immediate family (Spouse/Partner and children) living at the same address only.

a. * Children are classified and thus eligible to be included in the Staff (Bradfield & St Andrews staff)/Bradfield Parent membership up to the age of 19 only and living at home or whilst they remain in full-time education/apprenticeships until their 21st Birthday (proof of variation to be supplied on application).

b. All Children will be ineligible from the date of their 21st Birthday to be included in a Staff (Bradfield & St Andrews)/Bradfield Parent membership. They will need to take out an independent subscription.

c. Junior/Youth Memberships are available.

d. *Children who subsequently become pupils at Bradfield College may only join under the Bradfield College Student scheme. All applications are to be directed to Nick Taylor Head of Pupil Golf.
